Evidence presented by the Complainant/CRO:

The CRO received a complaint that the slate, *The Students Leading Change*, has put up their posters on various locations. There were many breaches reported and multiple





violations in the same building, many of these violations are within 10 meters. The posters are put up within 1 foot of other slate's posters.

Evidence presented by the Nominee/Candidate:

No evidence was required from the slate since sufficient evidence was provided
