



General Meeting Community Guidelines

Below are the rules that we expect everyone to follow in order to ensure TMSU's General Meetings run smoothly.

Speaking Privileges

All attendees are required to respect the speakers list, which will be maintained by the Chairperson. The Chairperson will call on you when it is your turn to speak. Speaking out of turn, yelling while others are speaking, and otherwise disrupting the meeting may result in you being asked to leave.

Decorum & Harassment

The AGM is a space for discussion and questions, not to demean or harass any individual or group of people. Our Anti-Oppression Advisor and Chairperson will intervene in any situations that cross the line, and you may be asked to leave if you do not alter your behaviour.

Rules of Order

Voting

The Chairperson will indicate when it is time to vote. In person you will vote by holding up your voter card. Online you will vote by selecting the option in the online poll. You are expected to vote when the vote is called, do not wait long to cast your vote.

Removal from General Meeting

The TMSU reserves the right to remove anyone from its General Meeting if they are making the meeting unsafe for others, or are purposely obstructing the progress of the meeting. Attendees may receive one warning before they are asked to leave.
